

Sportsplex COVID guidelines and precautions

It is our priority to protect the health of our patrons and employees. To continue to keep our facility operational, we ask that you please adhere to and respect these guidelines.

Social distancing of 6 feet is to be adhered to while using the Sportsplex indoor and outdoor facilities. (with the exception of members that reside in the same household)

MASKS are to be worn by all individuals inside the facility and during all physical activities, with the exception of swimming- (per EO-176 & 180).

NO LOITERING will be tolerated inside the facility

PLEASE ADHERE TO DIRECTIONAL SIGNAGE FOR ENTERING AND EXITING different areas of our facility.

USE OF OUR FACILITY IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. Our staff will be doing what they can to sanitize indoor high traffic areas, however, our available staff is limited. **PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELVES.**

NO large parties or groups, please.

POOL:

PATRONS MAY NOT ENTER THE FACILITY UNTIL 15 minutes prior to their pool time, to avoid overcrowding. Locker rooms will be unlocked 15 minutes prior to your Pool Locker room occupancy will be very limited. Please be prepared to enter and exit the facility assuming a locker room may not be accessible to you. Pool patrons are to enter the pool, thru the concourse, into the pool bleacher area, on the Southwest end. Our pool staff will be monitoring locker room attendance and sanitizing regularly.
E.O. 176 current Pool Deck capacity is 56 (25% of 225), Pool Bleacher capacity 38 (25% of 150)

ICE:

PLAYERS MAY NOT ENTER THE FACILITY UNTIL 20 minutes prior to their ice time, to avoid overcrowding.

Hockey patrons are to check in with our office and proceed directly to their assigned locker room. Please follow all directional signs in the facility and respect the social distancing guidelines. **ANY ICE USE SHOULD BE "NO CONTACT"** until otherwise permitted by the SPORTSPLEX

Hockey ice groups **WILL BE LIMITED TO 20** participants on the ice at one time, until further notice.
E.O. 176 current rink spectator capacity is 250 (25% of 1000)

ACTIVITY ROOMS/CONCOURSE: Social distancing is required in all areas of our facility, indoor social gatherings are currently restricted to 10 people, outdoor social gatherings are restricted to 250, per EO-176. Please adhere to the following maximum capacity for each space. Capacities guidelines for non-social gathering events held in our activity rooms.

ArtVan: max 15 people, Small room: max 25 people, Large room: max 35 people.

O. C. Sportsplex Hockey Tournament/Showcase Rules

The following guidelines are in addition to the COVID guidelines and precautions that are in place

1. Masks are to be worn by all players and their families and guests at all times. Players may not remove their masks in the locker room or while on the ice. They must wear them at all times.
2. The locker rooms will be available 30 minutes before the start of your ice time. Players please do not enter the building prior to that as loitering in the lobby and the rink is not allowed. All players must exit the locker room and the building within 10 minutes of the completion of the game. Spectators are asked to vacate immediately. Showers will not be available in the locker rooms.
3. The bleachers will be open for all hockey weekend tournaments and showcases. Please respect all social distancing guidelines when using the bleacher rows that will be open.
4. There will be no loitering in the lobby. Please limit guests to 2 per player, to accommodate our arena occupancy of 250 (Per EO-176). Family members and guests are permitted to enter the building 5 minutes prior to the game start time and exit immediately upon completion of the game. There will be no concession stand available and no seating will be available in the lobby.

The Sportsplex staff members, as well as the Gaylord community, are all excited to be able to host your team. Please respect our rules as well as our facility. Your cooperation will ensure that we are able to host these events in the future.
